



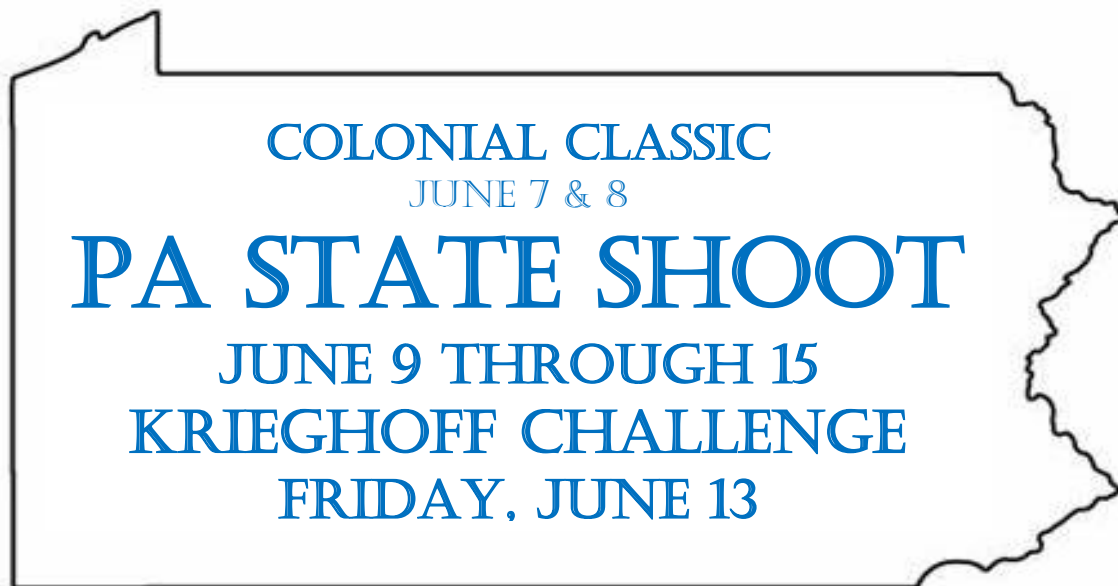

NOTICE TO ALL PERSONS ON THE GROUNDS **OF THE** **PENNSYLVANIA STATE SHOTGUNNING ASSOCIATION**

It is the policy of the Pennsylvania State Shotgunning Association to adhere strictly to all state and federal firearms laws and regulations and to require the same of anyone on the premises of the Pennsylvania State Shotgunning Association.

No person who is disabled by federal or state law from the possession of a firearm, including the frame or receiver of any such weapon, shall possess any firearm, or the frame or receiver of any such firearm, on the grounds of the Pennsylvania State Shotgunning Association. Any such person found to be in violation of this rule shall be immediately reported to the police and required to immediately leave the premises.

Any person who facilitates or enables the possession of a firearm, or the frame or receiver of any firearm, by a person who is otherwise disabled by the state or federal law to be in possession of a firearm, or the frame or receiver of any such firearm, shall be immediately reported to the police and required to immediately leave the premises.

Any person who shall violate this policy of the Pennsylvania State Shotgunning Association shall be disqualified from participating in any shooting event and shall otherwise be precluded from discharging a firearm on the grounds of the Pennsylvania State Shotgunning Association and such person shall forfeit any fees paid for targets, options and any prizes or purses.

Any person who, in violation of this policy, shall participate in any event in which the winner shall be entitled to a firearm, including the frame or receiver of any such weapon, shall be disqualified from receiving such a weapon, its cash equivalency, or any other award or prize and shall forfeit any entry fees or other monies paid to the Pennsylvania State Shotgunning Association for participation in the event.

Any firearm, or the frame or receiver of any such firearm that is forfeited by a participant for violation of this policy shall be awarded to the next eligible participant. If there shall be more than one eligible participant, such eligible persons shall shoot-off to determine the winner under such rules as shall be promulgated by the Pennsylvania State Shotgunning Association.

The interpretation and application of this policy shall reside exclusively with the Pennsylvania State Shotgunning Association. Any person who participates in any event conducted by the Pennsylvania State Shotgunning Association or who is otherwise on the premises of the Pennsylvania State Shotgunning Association consents to be bound by any determinations made under this policy by the Pennsylvania State Shotgunning Association, all of whose decisions are final.

The Pennsylvania State Shotgunning Association will have full responsibility for conducting shoots on the premises. All decisions pertaining to these shoots will be made by the Manager, under the supervision of the PSSA Executive Committee.

Project '24

This fundraising project is closed out. Thank you to everyone who participated in helping us raise the funds to install metal springs in all the traps, purchase 32 sets of BRB Voice calls, and begin working on new gunracks.

AIM/ SCTP/ USA Clay Target League

GENERAL INFORMATION

AIM & SCTP CHAMPIONSHIPS

SCTP youth shooters will compete to qualify for the national championship on Saturday, June 7 in conjunction with Event 1 of the Colonial Classic. This event will determine PA representation at the SCTP National Championships, July 12 – 19 at the Cardinal Center in Marengo, OH.

AIM youth shooters will compete to qualify for the national championship on Sunday, June 8 in conjunction with Event 4 of the Colonial Classic. This event will determine PA representation at the AIM Grand Championship, July 24 - 28 at the World Shooting & Recreational Complex in Sparta, IL.

ATTORNEY GENERAL'S CUP

The Attorney General's Cup will be given to the class and special category winners for combined scores in Events 13, 14 and 15 held Wednesday of the State Shoot. These trophies will be distributed to the winner in conjunction with the Hall of Fame activities. In addition, there will be a permanent Attorney General's Trophy maintained in the Hall of Fame and engraved with the name of the HAA winner of these three events. The classification and special category characterization for Wednesday's 16-yard event will control and be determinative of the winners. There will be trophies for Resident Class and Category winners.

CAMPING

The PSSA maintains a camping area with water, sewer and 30/50-amp electric hookups available to recreational vehicles. Rental is \$55.00 per night and subject to availability. Priority will be given to reservations by the number of days prepaid and postmarked prior to March 1.

Primitive camping is available for \$15.00 per night and **will now require a prepaid registration**. Our primitive camping area has ample space but limited to first come-first serve.

CASHIERING BEFORE SHOOTING

Shooters must be cashiered before shooting an event and will be disqualified for that event if this procedure is not followed. PAY first – then SHOOT.

CLASSIFICATION

Classification will open along with the office each day, and close ½ hour after the last event of the day starts.

The Classification staff will insist on having your latest ATA average card or print-out average card from the Shooter Information Center of the ATA website. Please make sure your card is up to date showing assigned handicap, current singles/doubles averages and all targets registered in the current and previous target years. Cell phones and other electronic devices will not be accepted. Current average cards can be obtained at: www.shootata.com

Click on “My ATA”; Login with your ATA number and password; click on “Print Average Card”

Erroneous cards submitted to the committee will result in disqualification from the respective shoot and forfeiture of all trophies and/or monies won. Any shooter who deliberately submits an erroneous card will be reported to the ATA for disciplinary action.

Known Ability will be used by the Classification Committee to assign shooters to a higher class than their average indicates if so warranted. Registered and non-registered shoots will be used by the committee as a basis for determining “known ability.” Abnormally low scores will be disregarded at the discretion of the Committee

CLASS – YARDAGE ADVANCEMENT

Any shooter who has the high score in their class, shall be increased a minimum of one Class. Shooters earning yardage must have their card punched before participating in their next Handicap event.

- **No class advancements for the State Shoot Preliminary Days (June 9-10). Subject to review by Classification Committee.**
- **The ATA 6 Class System will be used for all Singles/Double events during the Colonial Classic and State Shoot and the ATA 5 Class System for all other shoots.**

YARDAGE REDUCTION

Handicap yardage reductions received by a shooter during the course of a shoot shall be honored. The shooter must have the new card in their possession and present it to the classification committee for reclassification to their new yardage.

TARGET REQUIREMENTS

For the Keystone Open:

16 Yards and Handicap:

A minimum of 1,500 registered targets during the current and previous two target years, to avoid penalty class.

Doubles:

A minimum of 1,000 registered targets during the current and previous two target years, to avoid penalty class.

TARGET REQUIREMENTS (Continued)

For ALL other 2025 PSSA shoots:

16 Yards and Handicap:

A minimum of 1,500 registered targets within the current and previous two target years with 500 targets having been shot during the current target year, to avoid penalty class.

Doubles:

A minimum of 1,000 registered targets during the current and previous two target years with 300 targets having been shot during the current target year, to avoid penalty class.

TARGET REQUIREMENTS – PENALTIES

In the event the above target requirements are not met before the first day of each shoot, shooters will be required to shoot in, not less than Class A for 16 Yards and Doubles.

In Handicap, a shooter with insufficient targets will be penalized two yards beyond their ATA yardage with a minimum of 23 Yards and a maximum of 25 Yards.

- Ladies and Sub-Juniors who do not meet the Handicap target requirements will follow the same rules except with a minimum of 22 yards.
- Shooters who have reached their 70th birthday and declare Senior Vet or Lady II category will not be penalized for handicap events and are still eligible for trophies and money.

PENALTY YARDAGE MAY BE WAIVED BY ANY SHOOTER SO ELECTING; HOWEVER, SUCH WAIVER SHALL PROHIBIT THEM FROM WINNING ANY TROPHIES AND/OR MONEY (including Added Money) AND PROHIBIT THEIR PARTICIPATION IN SPECIAL OPTIONS, PROMOTIONS, AND THE KREIGHOFF CHALLENGE.

THIS DECLARATION MUST BE MADE AT THE TIME OF INITIAL CLASSIFICATION AND IS IRREVOCABLE FOR THE DURATION OF THE SHOOT (SHOOTERS WHO SHOOT DURING PRELIMINARY DAYS AND MEET TARGET REQUIREMENTS IN THE TIMELINE STATED MAY RE-CLASSIFY.)

CLOSING TIME

CLOSING TIME FOR EVENTS WILL BE STRICTLY OBSERVED. YOU MUST BE CASHIERED BY CLOSING TIME – NOT MERELY HOLDING A POSITION! SUBJECT TO CHANGE BASED ON WEATHER AND/OR ATTENDANCE.

DISCIPLINARY ACTION, DISQUALIFICATION & REINSTATEMENT

If a shooter does not abide by the Rules of the ATA, a shooter may be disqualified for an event or for a whole tournament at any time by Shoot Management or the Executive Committee. All shooters are urged to become familiar with the ATA's regulations. This policy is explained in **Section XII. Par. B of the ATA Rule Book.**

GOLF CARTS

Golf Carts, ATV's and similar vehicles may not be used on the premises until registered with the PSSA. A registration sticker will be issued upon proof of insurance and payment of a \$20.00 fee. Sticker is valid for all shoots as long as insurance remains in effect. They can be obtained during any PSSA event at the Courtesy Desk.

**UNLICENSED DRIVERS ARE NOT PERMITTED TO OPERATE MOTORBIKES
OR ANY OTHER MOTOR VEHICLE ON PSSA PREMISES.**

GRAND AMERICAN PARTICIPATION FOR CHAMPIONS

The PA Singles Champion and all Resident Category Champions will receive an additional \$150 if they compete in the Champion of Champions Event at the 2025 Grand American.

The five highest scoring resident shooters in the PA State Singles Championship attending the Grand American and competing in the Clay Target Championship will comprise the PA State Team and compete in the State Team Race in conjunction with that event. The participating team members will each receive \$50 from the PSSA. In the event of ties, the team members shall be selected by the PA ATA Delegate from those eligible shooters who are tied. The selection shall be based primarily upon consideration of the shooter's prior record in tournaments as well as the shooter's average for this year and last year.

Entries must be returned to the ATA by your State Delegate no later than 9:00 a.m. on Wednesday of Grand American Week. Please let your delegate know your squad and position prior to 4:00 p.m. on Tuesday of Grand American Week.

HALL OF FAME INDUCTIONS/TRAPSHOOTER OF THE YEAR/ STATE TEAM

Induction of Hall of Fame Honorees, as well as Trapshooter of the Year recognition and the presentation of pins to the members of the PSSA State Teams will be held on Championship Saturday, immediately following Event 20.

Any PA resident who is a member of the ATA may submit nominations for the Hall of Fame or Trapshooter of the Year to the PSSA Hall of Fame Board. Submissions must be made by November 15 following the target year end, to:

Hall of Fame inductees may be selected for their ability in the sport of trapshooting and/or their contribution to the sport.

Nomination qualifications for both are available on the PSSA website or by contacting our Historian, Bob Koeffer.

MISSED SQUADS – EVENTS

Individual shooters will not be paged during any event. Shoot management will keep the electronic ready board sufficiently ahead to give all shooters ample time to be at their assigned starting traps. Line personnel will be instructed to start each squad immediately upon the completion of the prior squad, without waiting for any individual shooter. Any shooter who is late for a sub-event will have to make it up at the practice trap, or where designated by shoot management.

If a shooter missed a sub-event, he or she should make every effort to complete the remaining sub-events with the squad and then REPORT TO THE PRACTICE TRAPS for instructions to make up the missed sub-event. DO NOT TAKE THE SCORESHEET TO THE PRACTICE TRAP. SHOOTERS MISSING MORE THAN FIFTY TARGETS MUST BE RE-SQUADED AND WILL INCUR A \$10.00 PENALTY.

- Shutt Scholarship and Save-A-Pair 50% donation / 50% payout
 - One random payout from all entries that played
- Purse 50% / 30% / 20%
- Great Eastern Purse 25% / 15% / 10% / 25% / 15% / 10%
- Open Options
25's \$5.00 each 25 100%
50's \$10.00 each 50 (F/M/L) 60% / 40%
- Class Purse 1 money every 7 entries
- Middle 50 Jackpot
Offered on all Handicap events for the Middle 50 Only.
 - ✓ You must play this option to be eligible.
 - ✓ Only a score of 50x50 on the Middle 50 will be eligible.
 - ✓ All ties will split the money.

In the event that there is no 50x50 on the Middle 50, the money will carry over to the next handicap event.

If there is no 50x50 on the Middle 50 in the last handicap event of a shoot, the money will be paid to the highest eligible score (and ties) on the Middle 50 of the last event.

PLEASE NOTE: The money will not carry over from shoot to shoot. The Colonial Classic, Preliminary Days of the State Shoot, and Championship Days of the State Shoot are considered separate shoots for option calculations.

NO REFUNDS ON OPTIONS FOR ANY REASON

PINS

Commemorative Pins will be provided at all PSSA shoots. Pins will be distributed at classification – one per shooter – until the supply is exhausted.

The PSSA will award pins to those shooters breaking either 100 or 200 straight targets for the first time at each PA tournament. Shooters, previously earning one of these pins, are not eligible for another.

PHOTOGRAPHS

A PSSA photographer will be available at posted times. All trophy winners are encouraged to have their pictures taken for submission to Trap & Field as well as an opportunity to commemorate their win. Additional copies will be available for purchase.

POSTPONEMENTS – CANCELLATIONS – ACCEPTANCE OF ENTRIES

Entries will not be refunded unless an event is cancelled, or by majority vote of the Executive Committee.

A postponement of an event to another day or time is not a cancellation and no entry will be refunded.

Management reserves the right to reject any entry for cause or to change the program due to weather conditions and/or attendance.

PRACTICE

Practice traps are located at the extreme northern end of the lower trap line. Parking and restrooms are located at the site.

Practice targets are \$7.00 per round and these traps will open ½ hour prior to the first event of the day and will stay open until the last squads begin shooting the last event of the day. Conditions and personnel permitting.

PSSA ANNUAL MEETING

The Annual Meeting of the PSSA will take place on Friday, June 13 at 8:00 a.m.

- Credentials of all club delegates, on forms supplied by the PSSA, must be returned to the Secretary prior to June 1, 2025.

All questions should be submitted, in advance, to the PSSA President so the PSSA has the opportunity to respond in an adequate and accurate fashion.

REDUCED PRICE FOR JUNIORS & SUB-JUNIORS

PSSA will deduct \$13.00 off all target prices for juniors and sub-juniors who choose to forfeit the right to play options. PSSA is committed to helping our sport by encouraging young shooters to participate but will not subsidize the playing of options. Shooters electing for reduced price targets are still eligible for the Krieghoff Challenge.

THIS DECLARATION MUST BE MADE AT THE TIME OF THE INITIAL CLASSIFICATION AND IS IRREVOCABLE FOR THE DURATION OF THE SHOOT. THIS DECLARATION WILL ALSO BE BINDING FROM THE COLONIAL CLASSIC THROUGH THE PA STATE SHOOT.

For example:

1. If you choose to play options in the first event you enter, you are not eligible for reduced price targets for the remainder of the shoot.
2. If you choose reduced price targets in your first event, that choice is binding on all events and you may not play any options for the remainder of the shoot.

REFUNDS

Refunds **MAY** be issued for emergencies and/or SERIOUS health issues **ONLY**, at the discretion of shoot management. **Under no circumstances will option money be refunded. Once options are paid, they are final.**

SCORES AND SCORING PROCEDURES

Scores will be posted on the scoreboard located on the front porch of the PSSA Entry Building. Shooters are reminded to check their scores and notify shoot management immediately if a discrepancy is noticed.

Scoring Errors: Management will not be responsible for errors in scores after the options have been posted.

- **FOR OPTION CALCULATION PURPOSES, SCORES BECOME FINAL ½ HOUR AFTER THE FINAL SCORESHEET FOR THE EVENT IS POSTED.**

SHELLS

- Vendors **WILL** be permitted to sell ammunition. All hours of operation will be at the discretion of the vendor. **Shell purchases are not compulsory.**

SHOOT-OFFS

Handicap: at the conclusion of that day's last event if weather permits.

Singles and Doubles: All shoots EXCEPT the PA State Shoot

- Singles and Doubles events will be carried over to the next like event in that tournament.
- Shoot-Offs for the final Singles and Doubles event, and all remaining ties, will be held following the final event of the day on which that event occurs.
 - **Singles and Doubles: State Shoot**
Singles event ties in events 8, 10, 13 and 16 will be decided by carry-over through the next like event. Event 20, and remaining ties, will be shot off at the conclusion of event 20.

Doubles event ties in events 12, 15 and 18 will be decided by carry over through the next like event. Event 21, and remaining ties, will be shot off at the conclusion of event 22.

SHUTT SCHOLARSHIP

The William L. Shutt Memorial Scholarship will be awarded to the outstanding Scorer/Loader annually. Funding for this scholarship will be provided by the Shutt Scholarship Options during the Championship Events at all PSSA shoots. Applicants should contact Steve Ross for details and requirements.

SPECIAL CATEGORY DECLARATIONS

Special category will be in accordance with the ATA rulebook Section IV, Rule K and L.

Special category changes will be permitted between the Colonial Classic and the PA State Shoot; however, the change must be declared before cashiering for any events in the PA State Shoot.

- **This allowance will not be permitted for Sub-Junior or Junior shooters, their selection will be binding from the Colonial Classic to the PA State Shoot.**

SQUADDING

A shooter will only be allowed to request one position per event per ATA number.

Shooters desiring to request more than one position per event must have the plastic ATA card(s) for each of the prospective squad mate(s) and the squad mate(s) may not have already reserved a position in the event.

Squads will be rotated per random draw done the night prior to the start of the day's events. After the starting positions are drawn, all squadding will be done on a first available basis. Shooters will not be able to choose the banks that they will shoot. Any abuse of returning and redrawing squads may subject violators to having squadding privileges suspended.

Shoot management will make every attempt to provide sufficient banks and flights to meet the needs of the anticipated number of shooters. Shoot management may limit the number of squads/flights for each event as conditions may warrant.

Squads for all events are available on a first come – first served basis.

In order to keep the shoots running in an efficient manner, new flights will not be added until the flights currently opened are sufficiently filled.

Please pull only the squad tickets you anticipate filling and relinquish unwanted positions as early as possible so that we have an opportunity to re-issue those positions.

TELEPHONE

There is a telephone in the PSSA office where you can be reached, if necessitated by an emergency at home. The number is (570) 672-9747. This phone is not available for outgoing calls.

TROPHIES

The current rules of the ATA apply to all PSSA sponsored tournaments. **CATEGORY SHOOTERS and CHAIR SHOOTERS should pay special attention to the new ATA rules.** Please make every effort to pick up trophies while at the shoot. If trophies are not picked up after one year, they will be repurposed at PSSA discretion.

TV-RADIO

On-deck squads as well as leading scores will be broadcast over the TV monitors throughout the PSSA main building. These will also be broadcast over channel 19 on your TV. Additionally, on-deck squads will be broadcast via FM radio channel 89.3.

VENDORS

Vendors will be charged a fee for each shoot. Prior permission and payment in advance, is required. All vendors will be required to show proof of liability insurance. Locations will be assigned by the PSSA.

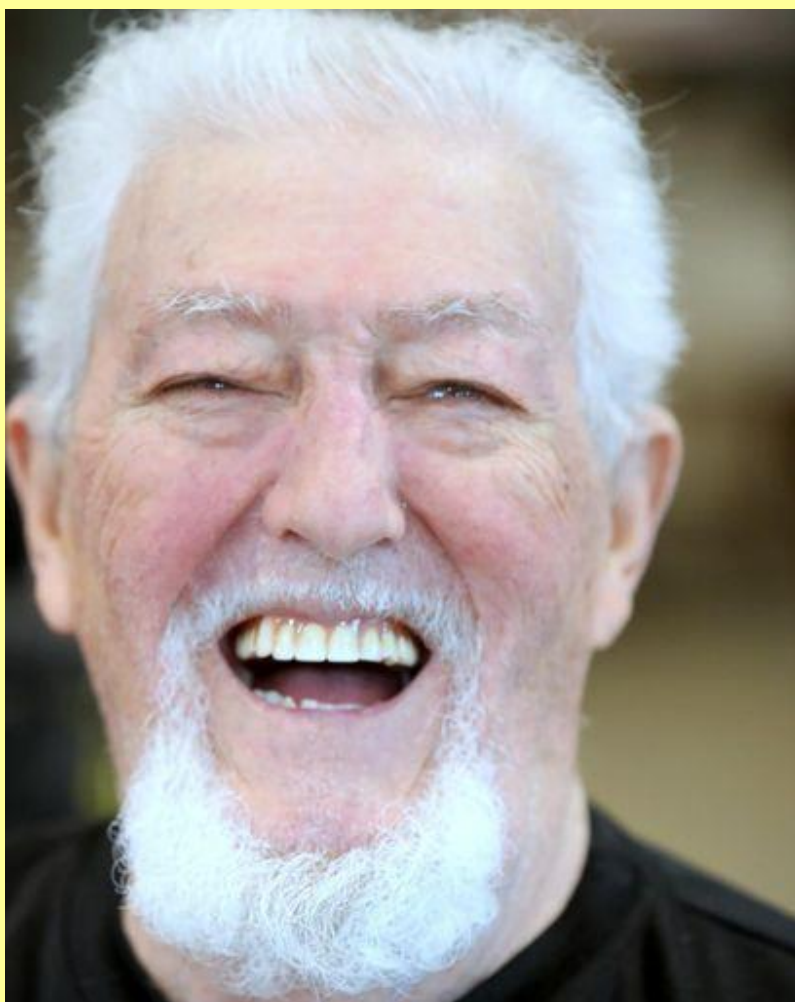

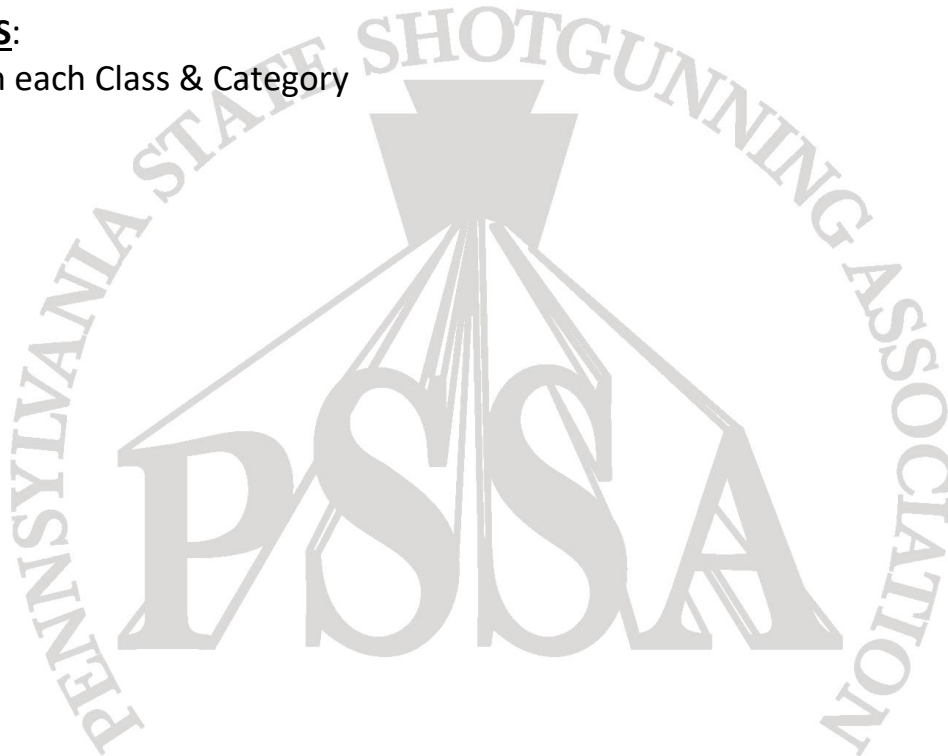

NICOLE HOOD

Miss Nicole Hood of Ashland, PA had what most people would consider a record year, traveling to 14 shoots and earning points at all of them. She attended State shoots, Satellite Grands & the Grand American to help her make the All-American team & the PSSA All-State Team; she was also the Hall of Fame's scholarship winner in 2024. The words "grace under fire" comes to mind when speaking of Nicole's accomplishments

As mentioned Nicole went to 14 shoots in 2024 including 5 in Elysburg, PA @ the PSSA Homegrounds. Starting in May at the Keystone Open she won 3 Champion trophies, The Keystone Doubles Lady 1 Champ, The Lady 1 All- Around & the Lady 1 High Over All Champ. Nicole returned a few weeks later for the Colonial Classic & State shoot where she took home 4 more trophies. She won Lady 1RU in the Bethany Breighner Doubles, Bradford GC Singles Lady 1, The Elysburg Handicap Lady 1 and the Doubles Class Championship Lady 1. July came around and so did the PA Grand and 4 more trophies! Three of them were Lady 1 trophies (Independence Doubles, the Doubles Championship and the High over All) and the fourth was All-Around Class AA winner. She finished July at the Summer Championships winning 8 trophies: 2 in Handicap, 2 in Singles, and 2 in Doubles the last 2 were All-Around Champion & High Over- All Lady 1 Champ.

Nicole participated in five other state shoots (Florida 3, Delaware 4, New Jersey 7, New York 7 & West Virginia 5) and four satellite grands (the Dixie Grand 9, the Northeast Grand 4, the Empire Grand 10 and the Southern Grand 3) and finished out her summer in Sparta Illinois at the Grand American. She gathered four doubles trophies: All American Woodworking Doubles, Lady 1, SOS Clays Doubles, Lady 1 RU, Excel Super 500 Doubles, Lady 1 RU & the Kubota Doubles, Lady 1 RU. Finally she won the Post Printing National Team Race as the Lady 1 RU. She had one 200 straight and two 100 straights in Doubles during the shooting season and made the All-American team and the PSSA State team. Add all of these accomplishments together and you can see why Nicole Hood has been nominated as PSSA Hall of Fames Trapshooter of the Year.
