**President's Report – Don Neilson**

**5-stand and ZZ Bird:** The participation at the 5-stand has not worked out like we had hoped. Rick Ott has agreed to have the 5-stand at the last 2 shoots at his cost. PSSA will supply the targets that have already been purchased.

The ZZ Bird was slow, but still going forward.

**EC Pig Roast:** The EC pig roast on Saturday, July 6, was a huge success!! We are hoping to continue this event next year. Thank you to all who attended and provided dishes for the event.

The corn hole tournament was well attended. We are looking for volunteers to run this tournament and an Annie Oakley tournament for next year.

**KI Gunsmith Room:** A preliminary proposal was sent to Krieghoff International concerning providing a gunsmithing room/trailer/tent for several days during the State Shoot. Possibilities include building a room on the front porch for them to use. Alex will get back to us concerning this.

**Financial report – Steve Ross**

**Financials:** Steve reported that, as of now, we have a profit of \$83,000. We still have fall taxes and other expenses to be paid. He is looking to finish out the year with a profit of \$25,000.

**Personnel:** Alexis will not be able to continue with her duties. We will be looking for someone to replace her.

**Shoot Report:** Each shoot this year has made money.

**Trophies:** Debbie is not available for the last 2 shoots, but she has designated people to oversee the trophies. Nick and Celeste Fantanarosa have agreed to help Debbie with the trophies next year.

**Fundraising**

**Project 24:** Steve Ross reported we have 36 sponsors for a total of \$48,430. He will send out receipts for tax purposes.

Brett Wells reported that people are interested in giving again. He will compose a letter talking about the success of the program.

**Speakers:** Seven sets of speakers are in with the eighth set coming this week.

**Gun Racks:** The gun racks are in the process of being made.

**Annual Raffle:** The raffle brought in \$25,820, gun costs were \$21,200 netting a profit of \$4,620

**EZ-GO Golf Cart:** The EZ Go financials were: \$2,750 (tickets sold) + \$11,415 (options) = \$14,165. The cost of the EZ go was \$6,360 which left us a profit of \$7,805

**Midway grant:** Sherry Anderson was not available to give a report. Brett Wells reminded us that he is available to help write the grant.

### **New Business**

**2025 Annual Raffle:** As decided by the delegates at the annual meeting, the 2025 annual raffle will consist of money prizes. The winning tickets will be drawn at the State Shoot on Saturday, June 14, 2025. Steve Miller reported that there will be 30 money prizes. 4,000 tickets will be printed initially. The cost will be \$10 each or 3 for \$20. We will look into including an option on the payment screen as well as selling actual printed tickets.

**Campground:** There are problems with the lower campground electric. Randy Parson has volunteered to try and figure out the issue along with Andy Sukel.

The campground will be open until the end of October or beginning of November. A notice should be put on Facebook and the website letting people know they can still use their campsites through this time period at the going nightly rate.

A site map for the campground will be put on the website.

**Other:** We received many compliments for the great targets that were thrown at the PA Grand.
