The meeting was called to order at 7:35 p.m. by Don Neilson.

A motion was made by Brian to approve the minutes from the previous meeting. Don seconded. Motion carried.

President's Report – Don Neilson

Telcomm: The new website is up and running and looks great. There have been many good comments about the new website. A suggestion was made to post QR codes around the main clubhouse so people can access the website/program easily.

20th anniversary of Krieghoff International: No update.

Super Clinic: Brian reported that there are 13 spots left in the clinic. A flyer for the clinic will be put on the website.

Financial report – Steve Ross

Financials: As of 4/16/24, the total revenue YTD is \$130,670 with the majority of the revenue coming from camping lease and rental. YTD expenses are \$60,883 leaving a net of \$69,787.

Camping: No new updates.

Personnel: New employee meeting was held on April 11 with approximately 50 attendees. Training started April 15 and will be held each week on Mondays and Thursdays. New inquiries about working are still coming in. Alexis is on board and working alongside Marian.

2024 Shoot Program: The basic program is finished and on the new website. The final version of the program is expected to be finished by May 1 and will replace the basic version.

Trophies: Debbie has finalized all the trophies for all the shoots this year. They are now being delivered and placed in Debbie's office.

Fundraising

Project 24: Steve reported we currently have 26 donors for a total of \$37,530 in donations. The next step is to order the BRB systems for a minimum of 7 banks. Hopefully, they will be in place by the State shoot. Brett reported that we need a follow-up of some sort for Project '24 so more people are aware of the project and they can join in on the giving. Possibly add the flyer to the website. It was suggested that a status report be added to the website of the improvements that are being made so people know what their money is being used for.

Gun Racks: Three pallets of composite wood have been delivered and will be used for the racks. Jim Hoffman and Andy Sukel will be cutting all the wood to proper lengths prior to assembly. A minimum of 2 more pallets will most likely be needed to complete the gun racks. The goal is to have the top line completed by the Keystone Open and all completed by the State shoot.

Springs: The springs are on all but 10 traps. They should be finished by this weekend. A big shout out to Andy Sukel, Jim Hoffman, Clayton Hoffman, Jim Stoner, Wyatt Corman and Lester Ott for spending the last 3 weekends changing O-rings and brushes, setting roller heights and cants, and leveling the machines. We are also planning to replace all of the rubber on the arms this year. Along with all the maintenance that was performed, we also plan to T-bar all the traps for 8, 9, and 10 foot target heights.

Annual Raffle: Steve Miller reported that the raffle is going well. He suggested putting a picture of the ticket on the website so people are aware of the raffle and the prizes. The sales will continue at the Keystone Open. Steve is asking for help selling the tickets at the Keystone.

Other: The Nickel Plate restaurant has agreed to do a 7-day fundraiser for the PSSA. This will take place during the State shoot. When you eat at the restaurant during those 7 days, 10% of your bill will be donated back to the PSSA. A flyer will be posted about this fundraising event.

EZ-GO Golf Cart: On-Time Printing is printing the tickets for this year's EZ Go Raffle. Tickets will be on sale at the Keystone Open and State Shoot. An option button at cashiering will only be available at the State Shoot.

Old Business

Traphouses: Traphouse repairs are being delayed due to other projects taking precedence.

Midway grant: Sherry Anderson sent Steve a grant check for \$2,626.

New Business

Facility Improvement Planning:

- Improvements are in the future plans for the trophy case
- Streamline the lines for squadding and cashiering
- Add more squadding workers in the mornings
- Have a window dedicated to shooters who are just shooting 1 day

Drainage: The drainage issues have been fixed behind banks 3 & 4 and banks 10 & 11. The project came in under budget. Kudos to Andy Sukel for a great job.

ZZ Bird: ZZ Bird will be set up for July 6 & 7 and July 27 & 28. We will use bank 11.

The next meeting will be held in person at the PSSA on Thursday, May 16 at 7:00 p.m.
